

Location

On the north shore of Lake Ontario, not far from the Thousand Islands and the mouth of the St. Lawrence River, is Prince Edward County. It is a peninsula jutting out into Lake Ontario, with 1000 kilometres of deeply cut inlets, sandy beaches, and limestone bluffs. One of the first regions of Upper Canada to be settled by the United Empire Loyalists, this area is "Ontario's best kept vacation secret". In the midst of this rural serenity is a very special spot - *isaiah tubbs resort & conference centre*.

DIRECTIONS

East

Take Hwy. 401 West to Exit 566, Hwy. 49 South to Picton, and Hwy. 62 to Bloomfield, Ontario. At the east end of the village, turn left onto Prince Edward County Road 32. Follow to County Road 12 (West Lake Road) and turn left. *isaiah tubbs resort & conference centre* is located 8 kilometres (5 miles) south-west of the village of Bloomfield.

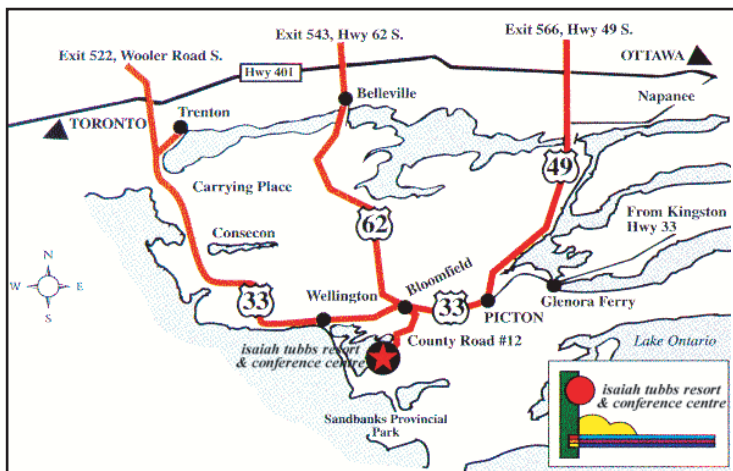

Take Hwy. 401 East to Exit 522, Wooler Road South. Continue south on Wooler Road and turn right onto Hwy. 33. Follow Hwy. 33 south to Bloomfield, Ontario. At stop sign, turn right. Take next right onto Stanley Street (County Road 12). Follow signs to West Lake and The Sandbanks. The *isaiah tubbs resort & conference centre* is located 8 kilometres (5 miles) south-west of the village of Bloomfield.

North

Take Hwy. 62 South (you must go over the Norris Whitney Bridge). Follow Hwy. 62 into Bloomfield. Turn right onto County Road 12. Follow signs to West Lake and The Sandbanks. The *isaiah tubbs resort & conference centre* is located 8 kilometres (5 miles) south-west of the village of Bloomfield.
